

Heart treatment - Rules for your regular medication before surgery

You should follow the patient information you received in connection with your invitation for examination/treatment.

However, the following applies to diabetes medication:

Long-acting insulin	Take as usual	Ex. Semglee, Toujeo, Lantus, Tresiba, Absaglar, Levemir, Xultophy Insulatard, Humulin NPH
Short-acting insulin	Omit during the fasting period	Ex. Actrapid, Humulin Regular, Apidra, Fiasp, Novorapid, Insulin Aspart
Other diabetes medication including combination insulin	Omit on the morning of planned surgery	Combination insulin: Ex. Ryzodeg, Humalog Mix, Mixtard, NovoMix

Note: If you are having coronary artery examinations and are using Metformin, you should pause Metformin 2 days before the treatment.
